





## PRESCRIPTION SCOPE OF NIMESULIDE IN INDIA AGAINST BANNED OF NIMESULIDE IN ABROAD

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## **ABSTRACT**

The Physicians and clinicians prescribe the most of NSAIDs in their daily practices under the different conditions while they have the wide choice for the NSAIDs. (Example Aspirin, Nimesulide, Ibuprofen, Diclofenac. etc.)

Nimesulide is mostly preferred NSAIDs in India and some countries. There is the controversy in the world between the Physicians, Scientist & FDA of different countries about Nimesulide side effects. This leads to banned, restriction, suspend of Nimesulide from some countries (Ireland, European countries) and some health sciences centre authority (eg. Singapore), FDA (United State).

Keeping this prospective in mind this study has been carried out with objective to know fact like use of NSAIDs in which mainly Nimesulide has compared with other most preferred NSAIDs. And counseling with Physicians and Clinicians regarding it's ADR and efficiency and monitor patients to whom Nimesulide has been prescribed.

A survey was carried out in rural as well as urban areas in Buldhana and Malkapur District of Maharashtra state India.

It involved analysis of 250 Physicians and Clinicians, 1000 Patients, 100 Medical Pharmacist in rural as well as 250 physicians and Clinicians, 1000 Patients, 100 Medical Pharmacist from urban areas. Among 500 Physicians and clinicians, 460 Physicians and Clinicians prescribed the NSAIDs under the various condition. Among 2000 Patients, 838 Patients has taken the NSAIDs as OTC and 1162 Patients has taken after RMP prescription. Apart from this we asked the relevant questions to Physicians and Clinicians, Patients as well as Pharmacist.

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
